We are partnered with the State of California Employment Development Department, San Francisco/San Mateo Workforce Services Branch and are proudly assisting with the 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual San Francisco/San Mateo County **Honor a Hero, Hire a Vet (HAH-HAV) Job and Resource Fair**. The job seekers will be able to meet with over 70 quality employers and approximately 30 supportive service providers to interview and obtain training and benefits information. Last year's event was a success with many Veterans obtaining employment and much needed resources. This job and resource fair is the largest of its kind in California, directly connecting qualified veterans with companies committed to hiring them.

**HAH-HAV** events are hosted yearly by the EDD at only 10 locations statewide. The first event was held back in 2007. Focused on attracting Active Duty Military, Veterans, National Guard and Reservists returning from active duty, the Job Fair will also be open to all job seekers and employers from the entire Bay Area. Previous Job Fairs have provided exceptional recruiting opportunities for employers in all industries. The job fair will be promoted throughout the Bay Area using public service announcements, EDD offices, Americas Job Centers of California, Veteran and civic organizations, colleges and universities.

This is a no-cost event both to jobseekers and employers. We are reaching out to you and businesses throughout San Francisco and San Mateo Counties to assist this great event with donations to support and to reward Veterans attending the job fair.
